Excused were Arline Ries and Mike Stone.

The August 2006 minutes were approved as presented.

Jeff Murray wrote a letter stating that he doesn't think Northland Alliance should disband as there are still things to do.

The treasurer's report was approved. We are still within our budget for the year.

The security report was given by Dave Kienzel. There was a homicide on Arborwood. Three suspects were apprehended in a home invasion on Vinewood Court. Several speeding tickets have been issued. A motion was made to donate \$100.00 to the block watch program for signs.

## FOREST PARK ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

Forest Park Elementary School has begun to implement a new process to improve behavior and raise learning outcomes for all students. The process is called PBS, Positive Behavior Support.

A lead team of four teachers and the principal will attend four workshops to become trainers for the rest of the school staff. The lead team includes Mrs. Meta Hahn, third grade; Mrs. Peggy Rowe, fifth grade; Sheena Davis, PEAK assistant, Sheila Garret, parent consultant, and Fred Tombaugh, principal.

The process includes positive feedback and proactive actions before behavior problems develop in the first place. "We will develop a support system that puts strategies in place to recognize positive behavior and limit negative behaviors in both classroom and non-classroom areas," explains Mr. Tombaugh.

Although all Columbus Public Schools are implementing the PBS process, it is individualized to the unique features of each school and will include creation of a school vision or statement of purpose; encourage school-wide expectations (rules); develop procedures to discourage behavior problems and provide ongoing monitoring of progress.

The first "Artist in the School" program for all the students will occur in November before the Thanksgiving holiday. "The American Jazz Experience" program is led by the founder Jim Masters, a musician, performer, and educator and includes a jazz band. The

program will include explanation and demonstrations of different jazz forms and stories about the history of jazz in America.

Fifth grade students will have an unusual opportunity on Wednesday, November 15, when they experience "Accounting for Kids." Several local Certified Public Accountants will talk about accounting procedures and the American stock market. The students will learn about stocks, shares and the in's and out's of the stock market. A pizza party will conclude the morning activities.

Other Important dates and activities include:

**November 9 and 16, 4:00 - 7:30 p.m.:** Parent Teacher Conferences. Parents/guardians are urged to call the school at 365-5337 to make an appointment with the teachers.

**November 21: Awards Assembly** in the Multipurpose room. Kindergarten - second grade 2:00 p.m.. Third - fifth grades 2:45 p.m. Parents will receive an invitation if their children are to be honored and are encouraged to attend.

**November 22-24, Wednesday - Friday,** Thanksgiving Holiday. School resumes Monday, November 27.
