This day is always of particular importance to me, as a native of Philadelphia, where the Declaration of Independence was written and first proclaimed, I used to march in the community parade in my mother's home neighborhood of Roxborough. My Uncle Bill was "Mr. Fourth of July" in Roxborough and always organized our church's section of the parade. It was always one of the highlight of my childhood years, and I have many fond memories of those days. We invite the Forest Park community to make new memories with us this Fourth. Celebrate your Independence by becoming part of YOUR neighborhood parade.



One note, this year there is a new rule in place. For a number of years, it has been traditional for parade marches to throw candy and other items for kids from the floats. Unfortunately, through the years, the kids have tended to go further and further into the street, causing a safety hazard. So starting this year, marchers will no longer be permitted to throw items from the street. This does not mean the end of the tradition, however. We will still be permitted to *hand out* candy as we march. Still, we ask parents to keep an eye on their children and keep them from running into the street to ask for candy. Stay on the sidewalk and grass, for everyone's safety. Happy Summer, & Happy Independence Day to All Forest Park Residents.

Forest Park Civic Association—Meeting Minutes of May 12, 2015

The meeting was called to order by President Ken Gilbert at 7:01 p.m. and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited, followed by the roll call.

Immediate discussion began about the delivery problems of The Forester. Homeowners in Kar-Mel received the April Forester even though some of our own residents did not. Delivery is missed, or thrown at the end of driveways.

Dave Paul reports that 55% of people recently surveyed stated that they are receiving The Forester each month. All agreed that is much too low. Suggestions put forward included: not paying the full delivery charge, delivering ourselves, using central locations where residents could pick it up themselves, moving to online only, reducing the number of issues, reformatting for mail delivery, and contacting big companies who use The Bag delivery system to make them aware that their marketing efforts are, in some cases, being thrown in refuse dumpsters.

Ed Vanasdale announced that the June meeting will feature a representative from The Dispatch to listen to our ongoing problems. A motion was made, seconded and passed to give Ed relatively wide leeway to deal with the delivery issue.

Dan Hartzell read the financial report for April. A motion was made, seconded, and passed to accept it as read.

PJ Phillips reported that she and George Schmidt have contacted all businesses in Forest Park and have 11 memberships. George indicated he would up to ten more if he had a fiscal year instead of a calendar year, and asked the board to consider offering fiscal year memberships. Ken said we are not going to change the year or offer a half-year membership - signing up now and qualifying for a directory discount more than makes up for the half year dues. Mary pointed out we should perhaps let the volunteers handle it in their own way. Ed agreed with Ken. The business membership team will go out again in the fall to solicit memberships for 2016. Regardless, this time can be used for relationship building.

The 4th of July parade needs a volunteer coordinator. Maybe we can coordinate something with Guitar Center – a staff member there has expressed interest in being in the parade. Marie volunteered to contact her. "50 years of working together" is the theme.

Ed or Catherine will submit an article regarding the city's curb replacement program.

Committee Report Highlight:

We have 402 memberships as of May 12th.

Meeting was adjourned at 8:49 p.m.

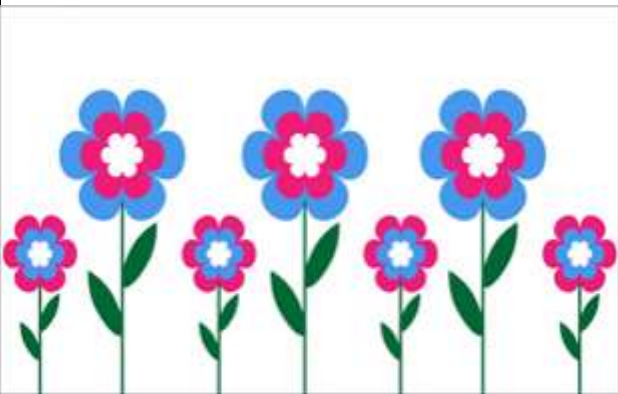

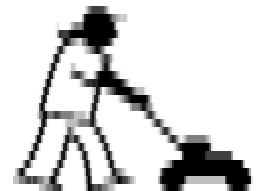

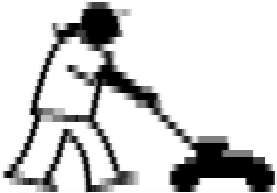
