Big Time Delivery

There are so many people who worked to assure the Forester would continue to be delivered. The person who by far receives our gratitude is Rita Woeste, the editor. Every month she beats the bushes for articles. Please submit articles to her. She brings in the ads, writes and edits. She gets it to the printer. Thanks to Cate Gilbert for caring for the financials and organizing the business ads.

We thank the printer, Paul Insley, Insley Printing owner, who must be printing them at cost. He always delivers on time with professional quality. Paul even unloads the 3000 Foresters into Donato's large meeting room. So thanks to Donato's Pizza on the Circle for letting us use the party room.

About two years ago we were challenged to find a way to get the Forester delivered. The Bag was not doing a good job and charging a good amount. Many, as much as 1/3rd of the Foresters were not getting delivered. We had to print extras to match their delivery areas. People outside of Forest Park were getting them and some in Forest Park were not on The Bag's route. Then The Bag decided to change the route that would call for Forest Park to print 6000 Foresters instead of 3000. Something needed to be done.

We started to recruit folks to stuff the Foresters into the plastic bags. Thanks to Ed Vanasdale for getting the bags for us. In addition folks were recruited to deliver the Foresters door to door. Some felt people would not deliver doing the winter. They were wrong. Well over 90% of the people asked directly said yes. Over 90% of the first people to stuff and deliver are still doing it. November Forest Park Block Watch Meeting Report

One of the reasons why I love attending the Forest Park Block Watch Meeting is getting the opportunity to hear first hand from our Columbus Police Liaison Officer Scott Clinger and one of the Columbus Police CRT (Community Response Team) Officers. This month we heard from CRT Officer Bill Marshall who spends time working in Zone 1 focused on criminal events that can take days to months to process and make arrests.

In the month of November we discussed the frustration with the Panhandling Law being no longer legally to be enforceable and our options for dealing with aggressive people we may encounter while waiting at traffic lights. While the Police will not respond to panhandling complaints, they will respond to people who are standing or walking on the freeway ramps - as that is an illegal offense. If someone is standing in the road and blocking traffic, that may also be called in to the non-emergency phone number of <u>614-645-4545</u> and pressing the * key. Please remember when calling these two issues in to make sure you mention what they are doing and what they are wearing so that the police know who they are looking for. Unfortunately, if you just can in and say someone is panhandling, they cannot respond to the call.

There will be no Block Watch Meeting in December, although there will be the quarterly Block Watch Coordinator's meeting at one of the local restaurants. Once the location and date are announced Forest Park will email the FPCA-enews group and post it on Next Door and also on the Forest Park Website at www.fpcivic.org. 


Holiday greetings to Forest Park!






