# NEW VOLUNTEERS FOR STUFFING/DELIVERY OF THE FORESTER!!!

We are in the process of reviewing the list of Forest Park residents who indicated a willingness on their 2018 Household Data Sheets to help with the stuffing and delivery of the Forester. It is the first year we listed these volunteer options and we are excited by this initial response.

We currently have a healthy attendance of stuffers each month; however, we can always use more because the adage of "more hands make quick work of a task" is true! We have fun visiting and stuffing together at Donato's on the Circle.

We can definitely use more deliverers to supplement the great volunteers we have. Our goal is to give each volunteer a "paper route" close to their home. New volunteers may give us the option to breakup some of the larger routes into smaller ones and more importantly to pick up additional areas not covered today by volunteers.

Volunteer deliverers should know we have the STEM group as backup. So, if you are traveling or unable to deliver in a given month, we can have the kids cover your route for that time period. Keep in mind you always have around a week to complete your deliveries. Our goal is to deliver the Forester by the first Sunday of the month; however, it's not a firm deadline that can't be missed by a day or two....

We deliver the Forester 10 months out of the year. January is an online version only and in the Spring one of the editions is mailed out with the membership campaign.

After the first of the year we will be reaching out to those who indicated a willingness to join our volunteer group of stuffers and deliverers to discuss their options and firm up their commitments. Our first stuffing of 2019 will likely be Friday, January 25th with delivery of the February Forester by February 3, 2019.



We would like to thank our current group of volunteer stuffers and deliverers and we hope you will all continue in 2019!!!

## **Guest Speakers for Meeting: Reps from National Church Residences**

Amy Rosenthal and Megan Kaple

Discussion concerned the property north of the CVS on Maple Canyon across from the Fire Station.

Application will done in February for Senior housing, previously requested for 75 units wasn't passed and now asking for 100 units. National Church Residences is going to ask for a 3 story building. Site is almost 4 acres and can accommodate the change. A variance will be requested in regards to the parking and the height of the property. They are wanting to make it look like the gabled roofs of the neighborhood. They are requesting 75 parking spaces. Minimum age group of the residents will be 55 and older. They have over 300 properites nationwide. It will be independent living with health care services offered. Next in the process is for National Church Residences to apply for a grant for Low income housing again to see if they can get this grant this time around. They feel that they can adjust their site plan to accommodate the proposed roundabout for that area. Sidewalks in area are unknown at this point. Of the 75 spots approximately 2 to 4 staff spots needed for parking. At this point the Manager will not be living on premises. Anticipate there will some sort of public space like a patio or green area for the residences. Inside will have a community room, fitness room, laundry facilities, small conference rooms. Average resident is typically late 70s and there are rent/income restrictions. They were not sure if pets would be permitted for this particular facility. Timeline: funding will submitted in February and hopefully will find out next Summer 2019, they said they will follow up with FPCA to let us know if they get the funding to move forward on this project.

### Welcome committee.

We have 2 months of welcome folders to deliver to folks. People in attendance were asked to help meet some of our new neighbors with the folders.

### **Discussion on Woodward Park**

Changing the hours for the area because of issues going on, and discussion with police liasion. Current time of park hours are from dawn to 11pm. Police Liasion is asking of for hours to go from dawn to dusk. Comments made: Police said we could schedule times for specific areas of the park and then keep the general park area from dawn to dusk. A Neighbor was concerned to leave park open and access for recreation. They want area accessible to the neighbors. Folks who play tennis want to be able to use it still. Will they keep the lights on for the tennis courts? Concerns of the speed coming out of the park area off Redwood. What provision will there be for bike path that comes through the park? One thing is that they are looking at school helping to maintain the dugouts of the baseball field. Concern that we are wasting a community resource. One resident said those responsible people who might use it after work will be considered the Bad guys because they want to walk their dogs and it happens to be dark when they get there after work in the fall and winter. No city park has traffic control and it won't be happening at Woodward Park.

The ball diamonds don't belong to Columbus parks and Rec but to the Columbus School Board. Our job here tonight is to give a recommendation to our Police Liasion of whether we support changing it to dawn to dusk, instead of dawn to 11 pm. More discussion followed. There was notice put in the November Forester about having this discussion, that is taking place tonight. Motion made to table this discussion for later date made by Rita Price and 2nd by Scott Prigan. 14 folks voted to table it out of 22 people. Folks felt other options were not discussed or thought through in this short time span. It was moved to table this to a later date. Notice will put in the Forester and Ed Vanasdale will notify the police liasion and Columbus Parks and Rec on FPCA's decision.

There is no Block watch or Forest Park Civic meeting in December. December is typically the month for a social gatherings for the FPCA.

Felix Quachey stood and stated he will run for President of Forest Park Clvic Association. He welcomes others to step up to the plate and put in their bid to run for office of President.

Folks who want run for office should notify the current President, Ed Vanasdale by mid Decmeber 2018.

Meeting was adjourned at approximately 8:19 pm.

# **Supplemental Security News**









With the holiday season upon us; here are a few timely reminders to help us all have a safe and secure season:

- Please do not have packages delivered to your home if nobody will be there. Most online retailers are happy to deliver to your workplace (if your job permits it). Amazon for example has lockers all over Columbus where your packages can get delivered to for later pickup.
- Please do not leave your shopping bags from your trips to the mall inside your car. They are better off locked in your truck whether parked in your driveway, garage, or the mall parking lot. Note that burglars will be very alert at this time of year and will be checking car doors and the cabin of vehicles for easy pickings.
- Gym bags should also be left in the trunk of your cars in order to prevent your cars from being broken into.
- Do not make your home a target for a break-in by leaving boxes of new appliances such as video game consoles, new TVs, etc., sitting at the curb for trash pickup. Take the time to break these boxes down to make them fit inside of the recycle bins.
- Please remember than any vendor coming to your door is required to have a City of Columbus issued Peddler's License with photo ID. If they do not have a photo ID, you can ask them to leave your property. Additionally, all vendors; licensed or not, must comply with a "Do Not Solicit" sign at your door.
- Pan-handling is against the law! You can call the police non-emergency number at 614-645-4545 then press \* to get directly to the dispatcher to have a car sent to remove the pan-handler. Note also that during this festive season, one could be tempted to hand some money to pan handlers. The police can and will write you a ticket if you are caught; and lastly,
- Be mindful of your surroundings at all times— do not exit your vehicle and immediately turn your attention to your phone. Keep your key fob in your hands and ready to sound the panic alarm when approaching your car in parking lots at night.


