As we are all enjoying the amazing weather that we've been experiencing, please remember that if you're walking your dog, your dog should remain on a leash at all times to prevent him/her from approaching your neighbors, getting into altercations with other animals, or running into the street and getting hit by a car.

As more people are housebound and working from home during the current pandemic, we are seeing more reports of gunfire. It is important to note that while we are hearing more disturbing sounds, our police liaison, Officer Scott Clinger, has confirmed that there has not been an increase of criminal activity in our area.
